BARS & CLUBS/ PERFORMANCE SPACES





Our a record label has an international audience in the millions thanks to pointblank's extensive global networks and reach. The label promotes in-house student talent from within pointblank's various international campuses and link new artists and producers with established industry figures such as Ultra Naté, Kathy Sledge, Kym Mazelle and Elisabeth Troy.






WELLBEING & MENTAL HEALTH

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

First and foremost, we are looking for people who can demonstrate their passion for music and an ability to successfully complete a Higher Education programme.

For access to the BA (Hons) degree programmes, typical conditional offers are made at:

- A Level: CC
- BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma: MPP
- International Equivalents

pointblank also accepts a wide range of other Level 3 qualifications. Please contact us if you would like to check your qualification.

English Requirement:

- English Language GCSE Grade C/4 (for UK students without Level 3 qualifications)
- IELTS Academic with 6.0 overall, minimum score of 5.5 in each category (applies to international applicants qualifications)

The Admissions Team will look at the merits of each applicant, taking the following evidence into consideration:

- Personal statement
- Predicted or previously attained grades
- Examples of work
- References
- Relevant work experience

Applicants without formal music / music technology qualifications or who have achieved academic qualifications lower than the typical conditional offer may be considered on the strength of relevant prior learning and experience.

This will initially be assessed through your personal statement which should include any previous study or relevant experience in music.

- * Applicants to the Music Production & Vocal Performance Degree will be required to submit an audition through one of three ways: pre-recorded video, live zoom or in-person audition
- * For pointblank's Music Business Degree, business or music-related subjects should ideally form a substantial component of Level 3 qualifications. If an applicant has no prior experience in business or music-related subjects then we may be able to consider an application if the personal statement indicates enthusiasm and an appetite for success within the music industry.
- * Applicants to the Music Software Engineering Degree would preferably need a science, technology, engineering or maths (STEM) related A-Level or equivalent and a GCSE grade 4 or above in maths. Typical offers for this course are made at BBC at A Level (112 UCAS points). If an applicant has no prior experience in STEM or music-related subjects, then we may be able to consider an application once further assessments are made through all or any of the following: admissions test, interview with an academic, or a maths assessment.
- * If you are interested in enrolling on one of our degree programmes but do not meet the entry requirements, the Foundation Year course could be for you. This course aims to build your confidence and provide you with the necessary transferable skills you will need to progress onto one of our undergraduate degrees. Entry requirements for the Foundation Year are: DD AT A LEVEL OR EQUIVALENT.

INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

Students from outside the UK wishing to study a course longer than six months may require a Student Visa.




Students on a Student Visa are usually eligible to work for a maximum of 20 hours per week during term-time and full-time (within certain limits) during official vacation periods, and full-time (within certain limits) for up to four months after studying a course which is longer than 12 months.

Those graduating with a full BA (Hons) degree may be eligible for the Graduate Route Visa upon completion, allowing an extra 2 years in the UK to undertake work at any level, in any field.

EU Students With Pre-Settled Or Settled Status

Students with Pre-settled or Settled Status in the UK are eligible to study a course at pointblank without the need of a Student Visa. We may request evidence of your status to determine your eligibility during the admissions process.










FEES & FUNDING




